Bhor

Bhor is a well known historical, religious and cultural tourist place surrounded by forts like Rajgad, Torna, Purandar, Rayreshwar, Rohideshwar, Kenjalgad; religious places like Mandhardevi, Balaji Mandir, Baneshwar, Nageshwar, Wai Ganapati and Bhatghar and Devghar Dam. Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, who ruled from the fort Rajgad for 27 years and established the *Hindavi Swarajya* was supported by warriors like Bajiprabhu Deshpande, Yesaji Kank, Murarbaji, Kanhoji Jedhe, Tanaji Malusare, Baji Pasalkar, Sarnobat Shidoji Thopte, etc. from this region. Bhor was also a Princely State ruled by Pantsachiv. Great film actor and producer Dada Kondke is from Bhor. Bhor Palace and scenic surroundings of Bhor are valued destinations for film and serial producers.

How to Reach Bhor

Bhor is a Taluka place and is well connected by road from Pune (55km), Satara (80km), Mahad (75km). There are regular buses from Swargate and Mahad and there is good connectivity from Shirwal(15km) and Kapurvhal (12km) on Pune Satara Highway NH4.
